
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ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT'S MOTION IN LIMINE

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on October 6, 2025 on Defendant's "Motion in limine regarding admissible evidence of past and future medical treatment or services expenses" filed on August 5, 2025. Plaintiff did not have health insurance and Defendant's motion essentially seeks to require the Court to place the burden on Plaintiff to prove damages in accordance with the Medicare reimbursement rate pursuant to Fla. Stat. §768.0472(2)(b)(3) and (2)(c)(2). After reviewing the motion, Plaintiff's response, and hearing argument, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED**:

1. To the extent Defendant's motion is seeking to have the Court place the burden on Plaintiff to demonstrate the Medicare reimbursement rate, the motion is **DENIED**.
2. However, Defendant is entitled under the statute to enter evidence as to the Medicare reimbursement rate.
